Time: 9:30 AM Mass

Where: First five rows in the center of the church

Participation opportunities:

Lectors: (*grades 4 - 8 only*)

- Choose two (they will sit with Yvette during Mass)
- Must be able to read well and attend one practice session

Gift bearers:

- Choose two
- Please arrange for someone to usher the children to the back of the church at the appropriate time.

Greeters: (A parent volunteer must be present to oversee the children)

- Choose four
- One at each door

Distribute bulletins: (A parent volunteer must be present to oversee the children)

- Choose four
- One at each door

Practice: In class if possible

Behavior: Discuss proper behavior in church with the class

Dress code: (Encourage Sunday best - guidelines below.)

Girls:

- Modest Dresses/skirts/dress pants (no jeans)
- Dress shoes (no sneakers)

Boys:

- Dress pants (no jeans)
- Dress shirt (no inappropriate t-shirts)
- Dress shoes (no sneakers)
